LOST AND FOUND

MTD maintains a Lost and Found Service for the convenience of our patrons. Lost Item Reports are completed for items lost in the same service day. Please call MTD's Administration and Operations Facility at 217.384.8188 to file a report. Please be prepared to give detailed trip information such as route, direction, bus stops, and travel times.

If more than a day has passed, customers are advised to contact MTD's Illinois Terminal. All lost items are logged and stored at the Customer Service Center for two weeks. You may call the Illinois Terminal Customer Service Center at 217.384.3577 or visit in person to inquire. Items are taken to Illinois Terminal throughout the day, but a significant amount of items are taken in the morning. Passengers are advised to call after 9:00 AM to inquire about individual items. Lost items must be identified and picked up within two weeks. MTD is not responsible for items left on buses, in shelters, or on any MTD property.

MTD reserves the right to change, delete, or otherwise modify its policies and procedures related to use of its facilities and services at any time. Safety and operational efficiency are of paramount importance. Policies may require modifications at any time.

Rules of Conduct

RULES OF CONDUCT

۲

To ensure that all customers have a safe and enjoyable experience, the rules outlined here are enforced on all MTD properties including vehicles, shelters, Illinois Terminal's interior/exterior, and MTD offices.

- A. Be courteous and kind.
- B. Please do not litter on MTD vehicles, at MTD facilities, or at MTD stop locations. Trash receptacles are on buses near the front door and at every facility.
- C. Eating and drinking are prohibited on MTD vehicles. Tobacco and nicotine products (including smokeless) are also prohibited.





D. RIDERS WITH DISABILITIES AND

SENIOR RIDERS HAVE SEATING PRIORITY. Please be courteous during boarding or alighting, and offer your seat to these riders when needed. The seats at the front of the bus are prioritized for seniors and riders with disabilities.

- E. Please do not use any electronic devices or musical instruments in a manner which may be distracting and/or offensive to others on MTD vehicles.
- F. Please do not use loud, explicit, or vulgar language. Behavior that interferes with the safe operation of the vehicle is strictly prohibited.
- G. Please wear proper attire. If you are not wearing shoes or a shirt, you will not be provided service.
- H. Solicitations are prohibited on MTD vehicles, at MTD facilities, or at MTD stop locations.
- I. Hazardous materials (for example, gas containers or vehicle batteries) are not allowed on MTD vehicles.
- J. Firearms are prohibited pursuant to 430 ILCS 66/65.
- K. Pets are allowed on MTD vehicles when transported in an appropriate pet carrier. Pets must remain in carriers at all times and may not obstruct the aisle. Carrier requirements do not apply to service animals for persons with disabilities. All service animals must either fit on a rider's lap or on the floor. Animals may not take up a seat.
- L. Passengers are responsible for carrying their pet carrier and any other heavy items. Operators may not provide assistance carrying heavy items on or off the bus. Do not block the aisle.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in the removal or expulsion of individual(s) from MTD property.

Fares & Transfers

Just \$1 cash fare per one-way ride. Fareboxes accept coins, tokens, and \$1 bills. Riders may use Token Transit (see page 14) to pay a one-way adult or student fare or to purchase a Monthly or Annual Pass.

High School and Younger Student Fare

Cash fare is \$1. Student tokens are available at \$3 for six tokens. Single token purchases are not available. Purchase tokens from an MTD operator prior to 7:00 PM, during normal business hours at Illinois Terminal (see page 1), or electronically via Token Transit. School tokens are accepted at all times. Only students in high school and younger are eligible to use school tokens. Individuals using school tokens may be required to prove eligibility.

Champaign Unit 4 and Urbana District 116 Middle & High School Riders

Certain students, whose eligibility is determined by their school district, may ride MTD to and from school. The students' school identification cards include markings identifying them as eligible. The ID must be shown to the Operator upon boarding. Students may ride in the morning and/or afternoon on school days only to and from school. Students involved in extracurricular activities after school may ride with their ID until 7:00 PM when boarding a route near the school.

Children's Fare

Children **46 inches or less in height** ride **FREE** when accompanied by a fare-paying or valid pass holding passenger. A yellow line measuring 46 inches to the top is found near the front door of all MTD vehicles.

University of Illinois Student, Faculty, and Staff Fare

UI students, faculty, and staff pay no cash fare. UI students, faculty, and staff must show their UI identification at non-iStop locations (see page 11). UI Visitor's Passes and temporary employee ID cards are not valid for a fare-free ride.

Those who do not wish to obtain a DASH Card may ride for \$0.50, which is half fare, but must have a valid Medicare card to show the bus operator. MTD Operators make change up to \$5.00 before 7:00 PM. Exact cash, pass, or Token Transit fares are required after 7:00 PM.

Passes & DASH Cards

ANNUAL PASS



The non-transferable \$84 Annual Pass is valid for unlimited riding for any 12-month/365-day period. If purchased at Illinois Terminal, the pass starts

on the first day of the month for which it was purchased. If purchased using Token Transit (page 14), the pass starts when it is first used. Purchases at Illinois Terminal may be made beginning one week before the month begins. Token Transit purchases may be made any time. The pass photograph is taken at no charge. Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and personal checks are accepted at Illinois Terminal.

VETERAN PASS



 (\blacklozenge)

The non-transferable Veteran Pass is available at no charge to Military Veterans. The pass may be obtained at Illinois Terminal with a VA Card,

Military Identification, Illinois Driver's License or ID with Veteran Designation, or DD214 accompanied by a photo ID. The pass is valid for unlimited bus rides for three years.

MONTHLY PASS



()

The non-transferable \$20 Monthly Pass is good for unlimited riding for any calendar month/30-day period. If purchased at Illinois Terminal, the pass

starts on the first day of the month. If purchased using Token Transit (page 14), the pass starts when it is first used and is good for 30 days. Purchases at Illinois Terminal may be made beginning one week before the month begins. Token Transit purchases may be made at any time. Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and personal checks are accepted at Illinois Terminal.

ALL DAY PASS - SATURDAY OR SUNDAY



Ride all day Saturday or Sunday for only \$2.00. On Saturday or Sunday, passes can be purchased from any bus operator until 7:00 PM. You may purchase these passes in advance at Illinois Terminal. These passes are not currently available on Token Transit.

DASH CARDS

Available for seniors 65 years and older and to riders with disabilities, the DASH Card allows cardholders unlimited FREE ACCESS to MTD's fixed-route bus service. The DASH Card is valid for three years and must be renewed upon expiration. All DASH Card holders must bring a valid form of identification and have their photograph taken at Illinois Terminal. There is no charge for the photograph. Individuals who qualify for both a Veteran Pass and a DASH Card will only be issued one of the two passes.

DASH Card for Senior Citizens

Persons age 65 years of age and older may obtain a DASH Card by providing proof of age at Illinois Terminal. DASH Cards will be issued directly to eligible seniors upon verification of age.

DASH Card for Riders with Disabilities

Medicare Card holders and persons having difficulty using an MTD vehicle may qualify for a DASH Card as a rider with a disability. Applications for DASH Cards must be submitted at Illinois Terminal and must include a copy of a Medicare Card or certification from an MTD-authorized agency. Please contact ADA Customer Service at 217.384.8188 for a list of authorized agencies. DASH Cards will be mailed within ten days to the applicant upon approval and after photographs have been taken at Illinois Terminal.

Persons 65+ years of age and Medicare Card holders who do not wish to obtain a DASH Card may ride for \$0.50, which is half fare, by showing a valid Medicare card.)

Bus Riding 101

mtd.org

Each and every rider takes a first bus trip. Take a minute to review these basics to make it easier for you. MTD's website (mtd.org/riding) has great resources, too.

۲

Which Bus Do I Take?

Everything you need to plan your trip is in this book or on our website. Start with the System Map inside the back cover to see which routes serve your area. An easy way to plan your first trip is to visit the MTD website at **mtd.org** and use the Trip Planner. Install mtd.org on your phone so that you'll always have information ready at hand.

Routing can change from daytime to evening, Saturday to Sunday, or whether it is a University of Illinois Fall/Spring semester day, so be sure to check the information for the day of the week and time of day you will actually be traveling. Having trouble? Call 217.384.8188 and we'll be happy to help. You can also visit Illinois Terminal's Customer Service Center if you have questions.

Where Do I Board?

- Board at any location where a bus stop sign is found. Special iStops on and near the UI campus are designated with the iStop icon . At iStops, it is not necessary for anyone to pay a fare or show a pass or UI identification card for certain routes. See page 11 for detailed information about iStops.
- Arrive at your stop several minutes ahead of the estimated departure time. Traffic and other factors impact travel time so there will likely be variability. Check MTD's real-time departure information (see page 12) on mtd.org or through an app. Data is updated about every 30 seconds, so refresh often.

How Do I Get the Bus to Stop for Me?

Look at the destination sign on the bus to identify its route. Wave to the operator so that they know you wish to board. Do not assume that the bus will automatically stop; **be sure to wave**! If you have difficulty stepping onto the bus and it would help to have the bus lowered or the ramp extended, please ask! While passengers are always encouraged to exit through the rear door to speed boarding for others, some may instead exit through the front. Please stand back to allow passengers to exit the bus and/or for the ramp to be extended before you board. Once all passengers have exited and/or the ramp has been extended, step aboard!

How Do I Get the Bus to Stop to Get Off?

About one-half block before your stop, pull the yellow cord or push a "stop" button to ring the stop request bell and illuminate the "stop requested" light at the front of the bus. The operator will stop at the next designated stop.

Where Should I Exit the Bus?

- Always exit at a rear door (if available). When the green light above the door is illuminated, the rear door can be activated by touching the silver handles. Use the front door only if you need the operator to lower the bus or extend the ramp, or if you need to retrieve your bicycle.
- After exiting, please wait for the bus to pull away before you cross the street so that you can clearly see traffic from both directions and so that oncoming traffic can see you. Safety first!

 Please have the exact cash fare of \$1, your pass, or your Token Transit app payment ready prior to boarding. Operators can make change up to \$5 prior to 7:00 PM, but having the exact fare ready speeds boarding and helps others receive on-time service. See page 3 for fare

payment options.

- If you have difficulty stepping on to the bus, ask the Operator



to lower (kneel) the bus. You may also request that the ramp be deployed. Please note the Operator does not automatically kneel the bus or lower the ramp but will be happy to do so upon request.

 Please sit when possible, or stand and secure yourself.
 Stand at the front only if the bus is full. You must stand behind the white line at front, just behind the Operator.

How Do I Transfer to Another Route?

 $(\mathbf{\Phi})$

Immediately upon boarding, if you paid with anything other than a pass, request a free transfer from the Operator. Inform the Operator of the route to which you are transferring and where on the route the transfer is to be made. If necessary, your operator will contact the connecting bus and advise them to expect you. The connecting bus may only wait up to two minutes past the scheduled departure time. Every effort will be made to assist passengers in completing transfers without significantly delaying service to others. The connecting bus cannot wait longer than two minutes because other passengers' trips may be disrupted by a longer wait. If the scheduled arrival time of your bus and the scheduled departing time of your connecting bus are scheduled to be very close, please consider taking an earlier trip to ensure you arrive at your destination on time. You may only transfer at a point where routes intersect. The transfer is valid only on the first connecting route/service and is not valid for a round trip.

RIDING

- Please consider giving your seat to passengers who are elderly, disabled, or pregnant, or who have difficulty standing; it is courteous to give them priority, particularly in the front section of the vehicle. There are many seats on the bus but only the front seats can be used by passengers in wheelchairs and passengers with strollers. This area allows them access to the wheelchair securements.
- Generally, be kind. Please be considerate of your fellow passengers. Use headphones when listening to music and minimize cell phone conversations. See page 2 for Rules of Conduct when riding the bus.

WELCOME TO MTD AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS!

University of Illinois students, faculty, and staff have unlimited access to all MTD bus routes and services at all times both on campus and throughout the community. A valid University of Illinois iCard identification must be presented when riding community services.

This book has lots of great info: learn Bus Riding 101 on page 5, go to page 12 to learn how to use the realtime departure system, get a jump on the "Hoppers" on page 13, and review the service calendar on page 8. Visit our new website at mtd.org to try the Trip Planner and get quick access to all things MTD. Install the mobile-friendly mtd.org on your phone or grab an app and always have bus info at your fingertips!

A key thing to know is that MTD service operates nearly 24/7 during the UI Fall and Spring semesters, but service is reduced during breaks and summer. 335 SafeRides, a demand-response service, is available within certain boundaries at night (see page 109). On campus, no iCard or fare is needed when buses stop at special iStops (see page 11). It's important that you learn street names and cardinal directions (north, south, east, and west), and always be aware of where you are. Enjoy your time here!

- UI students, faculty, and staff do not need to pay a cash fare or purchase a pass. All you need to ride is your iCard! Make sure to always have it with you and be ready to show it to the Operator.
- Use the trip planner at mtd.org, in an app, or on Google Maps to plan a trip. Detailed information is returned in an instant.
- Be at your stop early! We suggest you be at the stop at least five minutes before the departing time. The schedule for timepoints

- Always exit out a rear door. This reduces congestion at the front door for passengers boarding.



SERVICE REDUCTIONS DURING UI BREAKS & SUMMER

During University of Illinois Fall, Winter, and Spring breaks as well as Summer Session I and Summer Session II, MTD reduces service as shown below. See page 8 for specific dates.

- **2 Red Express** trips, designated with L and U footnotes, do not operate.
- **12 Teal** "U" trips do not operate. The route operates at 20-minute frequencies.
- 13 Silver "U" trips do not operate. The route operates at 20-minute frequencies.
- **130 Silver Limited** operates abbreviated routing during the evening and weekend at 20-minute frequencies.

22/220 Illini Limited operates abbreviated routing during all day types at 30-minute frequencies. No Late Night service on the 50 Green, 100 Yellow, 120 Teal, 130 Silver, and 220 Illini. No Sunday Evening & Late Night service.

335 SafeRides operates with only one van and only until midnight during breaks. 335 SafeRides does not operate at all during Summer Sessions. Designated pickup locations are not served.

HOME FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL GAME REROUTES

MTD loves Illini sports! So much so that we operate the 280 tranSPORT (see pages 143 and 144) for all home football games, even Friday night games. The first trips depart for Memorial Stadium two hours before kick-off and the final trips to the stadium depart 15 minutes after the game begins. Passengers can return from the game anytime during the game. The last return trips depart Memorial Stadium 30 minutes after the game ends. As for the rest of our routes on game days, MTD puts the 100 Yellow and sometimes the 220 Illini on reroute for home football games because of lane closures on First Street and the complete closure of Lot E-14. Weekday Illini basketball games beginning at 6:00 PM can also result in reroutes. Create an account on mtd.org to get customized reroute alerts via text, email, or follow us on Twitter at @ridemtd!





Universal Transfers are provided on weekdays three times each day at Illinois Terminal: 6:35 AM, 7:40 AM, and 11:11 PM. There is also a 7:40 AM guaranteed transfer at Lincoln Square. At Illinois Terminal, routes stop as shown below. At Lincoln Square, routes use ordinary stops. MTD guarantees that passengers will be able to make their transfer at these places at these times. All departing routes will hold until all passengers have completed their transfers. It is not necessary to ask your operator to call ahead to hold a bus for you when transferring at these times. (Please note that the particular order of buses shown on each platform below may change on a daily basis.)

All MTD bus stops are identified with a bus stop sign such as the one at left. MTD will only board and alight passengers at these bus stops. On the University of Illinois campus, certain MTD stops are iStops (see below) where no pass or fare is needed, but only for certain routes.

Bus stop signs include the stop name, the route(s) that serve the stop, and the stop code for accessing real-time departure times through Bus Stop Lookup, mtd.org, and apps. The stop's code to text to 35890 for real-time departure(s) is included as well as MTD's phone number and web address. Most bus stop signs will have MTD's former web address (cumtd.com) but anyone visiting that web address will be redirected to mtd.org.

iStops

iStops are special stops located in the University District as well as at ONE Illinois North, ONE Illinois South, Capstone Quarters, and Campus Circle. At iStops, in order to speed up boarding, it is unnecessary for anyone to pay a fare or show any sort of a pass or ID when riding these routes: 1/100 Yellow/YELLOWhopper, 10 Gold/GOLDhopper, 12/120 Teal, 13/130 Silver and Silver Limited, 21 Raven, or 22/220 Illini and Illini Limited. Any other routes that board passengers at these stops require a cash fare be paid or a pass/ID be shown. Boundaries for iStops are described below. Signage at iStops shows the iStop symbol next to the eligible routes. Route maps in this book identify the iStops with the symbol at right. STOPwatch kiosks on campus include the iStop symbol alongside information for routes for which no ID, pass, or fare is required.

1/100 Yellow/YELLOWhopper: No ID, pass, or fare is required northbound at any stop from Lot E-14 to Stoughton & Wright. No ID, pass, or fare is required southbound at any stop from White & Wright to Lot E-14.

10 Gold/GOLDhopper: No ID, pass, or fare is required from Lot E-14 to Goodwin & Springfield.

12/120 Teal: No ID, pass, or fare is required westbound at any stop from FAR-PAR to Stoughton & Wright. No ID, pass, or fare is required eastbound at any stop from White & Wright to FAR-PAR.

13/130 Silver and Silver Limited: No ID, pass, or fare is required north of Vet-Med and south of Goodwin & Springfield.

21 Raven: No ID, pass, or fare is required anywhere on this route.

22/220 Illini and Illini Limited: No ID, pass, or fare is required at any stop south of University Avenue nor at southbound stops at Capstone Quarters, ONE Illinois North, One Illinois South, or Campus Circle.

Remember that on your return trip if you board different routes or board outside the iStop boundaries you will need to pay a fare or show your pass or ID. So always have your pass, ID, cash, Token Transit app, or token ready for your return trip!

Real-Time Info

Simplify trip planning and minimize wait times with MTD's real-time system, which identifies each departure point and generates real-time departure estimates. The sophisticated system communicates with our GPS-equipped vehicles so you may learn precisely when a vehicle is expected to depart its stop. In real-time. This makes trip planning a breeze through mtd.org and apps. Access this information with your computer or mobile device, or view it on kiosks at high-ridership stops. Estimates are updated every 30 seconds (results auto update).

MTD's Trip Planner is a tool for planning trips. In the **Trip Planner** at mtd.org, simply enter "to" and "from" addresses, intersections, or landmarks to learn which route(s) to take and the information on transfers you need. Customize trip planning to a specific day, time of day, and/or arrival and departure times.




Send SMS texts to get real-time info sent directly to your mobile device. After texting a stop code to the MTD SMS number (35890), you will receive a response text within seconds with the real-time departure estimates of the bus(es) serving that stop. See below for detailed instructions. Find stop IDs using **Bus Stops** at mtd.org, on bus stop signs, inside and outside bus shelters, on schedules, and on electronic signs at select bus stops.

At the Stop - Numerous stops, with more on the way, are equipped with **LED and LCD signs** displaying real-time departure information for the routes serving that stop. Passengers may see precisely how many minutes it will be until their bus departs. These signs also display important service announcements.

High-frequency Hoppers primarily connect downtown Champaign, downtown Urbana, and the University of Illinois. Parkland College is served by the 5 GREENhopper on weekdays and the 50 GREENhopper on weekday evenings. High-frequency service makes it quick and easy to get to work, entertainment, medical, dining, and academic destinations in the downtowns, on campus, and all places in between.

۲

MTD Hoppers can deviate a bit from the usual path of a route and, combined with regular service, operate at either 10- or 15-minute frequency on the parts of the routes with greatest demand. There is little need to reference a timetable with this super high-frequency service.

Hopper Destination Signs



If the destination sign indicates that the bus is operating as a Hopper, that particular bus does not continue all the way to the east/west or north/south end of that route. If you wish to travel beyond the Hopper portion of the 1 Yellow, 5/50 Green, 6 Orange, or 10 Gold route, you need to board a bus which does not include Hopper on its destination sign.

MTD has four routes which include Hopper service: 1 Yellow, 5/50 Green, 6 Orange, and 10 Gold. The term Hopper appended to a route name indicates that the buses operating on these routes (designated 1 YELLOWhopper, 5/50 GREENhopper, 6 ORANGEhopper, or 10 GOLDhopper) do not traverse the entire length of their parent route from end-to-end. Trips highlighted in color on schedules detail which trips are Hopper trips. The destination signs will also differentiate between Hopper trips and regular service.

Token Transit

Token Transit Electronic Fare Payment

Using Token Transit for fare payment offers riders a great alternative to cash with the option to pay for one ride or purchase a pass with a credit card, debit card, or prepaid debit card. These can be used immediately or stored on the Token Transit app for future trips and activation. Here's what you need to do.

ACTIVATE

When you're ready to ride, tap your pass stored in your Token Transit account to activate it. The image, color, and wording on passes are unique to the day on which the fare is activated. Once activated, a one-ride fare or student fare will only be activated for TEN minutes. After ten minutes the fare expires and can no longer be used.

The Monthly Pass is valid for 30 days from the date you first use it. The Annual Pass is valid for 360 days from the date you first use it. (Note that you can buy the Monthly or Annual Pass with Token Transit any time during the month.)

As you board the bus, show the bus Operator your digital ticket on your smartphone. That's it! If you are traveling with others, and have purchased and activated multiple fares or passes on a single phone, show the first activated pass to the Operator which will note how many passes are currently activated.

Remember...the \$1 one-ride fare or student fare is valid for only ten minutes after activation, so do not activate it until you see the MTD bus you wish to board.



How to Read a Schedule

- Find the correct bus schedule for the specific day and time you want to travel. Routing and schedules vary from day-to-day and at different times of day, so please be careful to select the correct schedule.
- Select the direction you will travel.
- Locate the timepoint closest to the location at which you wish to board and estimate the required travel time from that point to your destination. Or simply let the Trip Planner do the calculations for you (see page 12).
- 4 Read down the column of times under the timepoint you've chosen until you find your desired departure time.
- (5) Read across that row of the timetable to estimate your arrival time at your desired destination.
- Timepoints are identified with a letter/circle. Find this letter/circle on the map for this route for the precise location of the stop. Buses will not leave a timepoint earlier than the scheduled time.
- Each stop has an identification code, the letters "mtd" followed by four digits (e.g. mtd3171), which you can use with MTD's STOPwatch real-time information system. See page 12 for details about STOPwatch.
- 8 Letters or symbols before or after a time indicate that the route deviates from normal at this time. Each letter/ symbol corresponds to a footnote beneath the schedule or at the end of the Weekday Daytime section of the book if related to a school trip. Be certain to read the footnote if you are planning to travel at this time!
- In the symbol means that the route ends at this time. The route <u>may</u> continue with Evening or Late Night service, but please be sure to reference the Evening/Late Night schedule and map as the routing and timetable may change.

How Does It Work?

First, you apply for your shelter of interest. After you've adopted a shelter, a sign is installed on the shelter informing the community of your commitment. We'll give you the necessary tools to keep your shelter clean. As the adopter, this is <u>your</u> stop and you claim responsibility for the shelter's upkeep. This means you will make monthly trips (at least) to the shelter to complete your duties. If problems arise, please inform MTD immediately at 217.384.8188 or adoptashelter@mtd.org so that we can address the problem.

You commit to one year in the program when you sign up. Thereafter, you may continue in the program on a month-to-month basis.



The process to make over MTD's website began well over a year ago with an internal team working on wholesale changes. MTD's Developer and internal website team worked with a design firm to identify opportunities for improvements and redesign.

However, by far the biggest influence on the redesign was you, the user. Dozens of usability testing sessions were held with users to understand preferences and hear suggestions. Bikes on Buses

All MTD vehicles are equipped with bike racks. Each vehicle can accommodate up to two bicycles. Motorized or electric bikes are prohibited on the bike racks. Bikes ride FREE when accompanied by a farepaying passenger; no special permit is required. You must be at least 13 years old to use the racks, unless accompanied by an adult. MTD is not responsible for personal injury, property damage, or property loss arising from use of this equipment. Use at your own risk.

GETTING READY

- · Before the bus arrives, remove anything that may fall off the bike.
- If the bike rack is full, please wait for the next available bus. Do not attempt to bring your bike inside the bus, unless it is a folding bike properly prepared for boarding (see below).
- For safety and security reasons, the operator cannot leave the bus to assist with the loading or unloading of bicycles.

GETTING ON

- For your safety, load from the curb side. Avoid approaching the bus from the street side when loading your bike.
- Load your bike as quickly as possible to ensure that fellow passengers reach their destinations on time.
- A 1. Lower the carrier rack located in front of the bus with one hand while holding your bike with the other hand. Grasp the handle, squeeze, and pull towards you until the rack is completely lowered.
- B 2. After lowering the rack, lift your bike into the wheel well. If yours is the first bike or only one bike is being loaded, put it in the position nearest the bus, handlebars toward the curb.
 - 3. Swing the arm up and over the front tire of the bike. A strong spring pulls the arm down onto the tire and holds the bike securely.
 - 4. After securing the locking arm over the tire, board the bus and sit as close to the front of the bus as possible, keeping your bike in view.

GETTING OFF

(

- 5. Let the operator know you will be removing your bike from the rack and exit the front door.
- 6. Always unload your bike from the curb side.
- **D** 7. Raise the support arm off the tire.
 - 8. Lift your bike out of the rack.
 - 9. If yours was the only bike on the rack, squeeze the handle and lift to return the rack to its upright position.
 - 10. Finally, move quickly away from the bus to the curb and let the operator know it is safe to leave.

FOLDING BIKES

A folding bicycle has a frame that folds and two wheels that come together.

FOLDING BICYCLES ARE PERMITTED ON MTD VEHICLES UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- The folding bicycle must be folded prior to boarding.
- The folding bicycle must not block the aisle or doors.
- Passengers shall have priority for seating over a folded bicycle.
- Cyclists are responsible for their own bicycle and all actions, injuries, losses and/or damages related to their bicycle on MTD vehicles.


Environmental Commitment

Solar


MTD's solar array has been soaking up rays to provide electricity for our Maintenance Facility since September 2014. Last year, MTD's solar panels produced over 263,158 kWh of solar energy. That's a 17% reduction in purchased electricity! Hybrid Buses

MTD welcomed four new diesel-electric hybrid buses to the fleet in early 2018, bringing the portion of hybrid buses to 80%. These new buses replaced older standard diesel buses. In late 2018, MTD plans to replace three more of the older standard diesel buses with diesel-electric hybrid buses. This will bring MTD's fleet to 83% hybrid.





ISO 14001:2015 Certification

In 2013 MTD became the first transit provider in the state of Illinois and the sixth in the country to achieve ISO 14001:2004 Certification for its Environmental and Sustainability Management System (ESMS). The ESMS guides improvement in the environmental impact of the District's activities. 
New streetscape improvements, a transit boarding island on Green Street, a reconfigured Illini Union vehicle entrance and parking, all-way pedestrian crossings, and protected bicycle lanes are some features that are already having a transformative impact on the critical downtown-to-Campustown links in the core of our community. The final project designs included careful consideration of feedback received from stakeholder meetings and outreach, web form submissions, and surveys.



Traditionally, transportation network improvement projects on and around the Urbana-Champaign campus are phased-in following Commencement and completed prior to the start of the Fall semester to minimize potential inconveniences.

Due to federal funding requirements, MCORE project work began and will continue while the University of Illinois is in session.

Projects 1 and 2 are substantially complete. Project 3 is underway and is expected to continue through approximately November 2018. Projects 4 and 5 will begin in Spring 2019 with a completion date in 2020.

Real-time information and planning tools reflect any long-term reroutes. MTD will also make regular reports on our social media channels including Facebook and Twitter.

In 2018 and 2019, work is planned for White Street, Wright Street, and Green Street (see page 23) as well as Armory Avenue. Many MTD routes operate on these core campus streets and service must be rerouted. MTD will post information along the route and, where possible, will identify stops with a blue painted MTD logo on the sidewalk at the boarding/alighting locations (see image at right).

There is no SafeRides on the following Sundays due to reduced service: 2018: November 18, December 23, and December 30 2019: January 6 and March 17 There is no SafeRides service during the University of Illinois Summer Sessions I and II.

What it is:

The purpose of 335 SafeRides is to provide safe transportation to individuals who are generally traveling alone and when no other means of safe transportation are available within the designated 335 SafeRides boundaries. There is a maximum limit of three persons per pick-up location, except at the designated pick-up locations of the Illini Union, ISR, and the Main Library at Armory & Wright. 335 SafeRides does not duplicate fixed-route service already provided by MTD. 335 SafeRides does not provide emergency transportation services to medical facilities. 335 SafeRides does not provide service to and from bars.

How to use it:

This depends on where you are, where you want to go, and what time it is. From Dusk (7:00PM/5:00PM) until 6:00AM you can use 335 SafeRides by calling 217.265.7433 anywhere within the designated boundaries (see map on next page), provided there are three persons or less at the pick-up location and the trip cannot be completed directly on a fixed route. Provide the dispatcher with the following information: your name (first and last), phone number, pick-up location (street address/landmark), and destination. If your trip is within the 335 SafeRides boundaries, the dispatcher will then inform you of a scheduled pick-up time.

Expect waiting times of 15 minutes during the week and up to 30 minutes on the weekend when demand is higher. Upon boarding the 335 SafeRides van, the person who scheduled the trip will be required to display their valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. As a courtesy to other 335 SafeRides passengers, please be at the scheduled location when the operator arrives. Upon arriving at a pick-up location, the 335 SafeRides operator will **only wait two minutes** for passengers to board before continuing to the next scheduled pick-up/drop-off location. Calls for 335 SafeRides will be taken until 6:00AM for trips to be completed by 6:30AM.

From 9:00PM to 3:00AM you can board a 335 SafeRides vehicle without scheduling a pick-up at either Armory & Wright, the Main Library (:27 and :57 after the hour); Illinois Street Residence Hall (:27 and :57 after the hour); or the Illini Union (:00 and :30 after the hour). When boarding the 335 SafeRides van, you will be asked to display your valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. After 3:00AM, routine pick-ups at the Main Library, Illinois Street Residence Hall, and the Illini Union are discontinued. Please call to make arrangements for a pick-up.

If your pick-up and drop-off locations are both directly on any fixed route (example: residence hall to residence hall trips) and/or there are more than three persons traveling together, you will be required to use the fixed routes to complete your trip. A ride on MTD's fixed-route service is also considered a safe ride.

The 280 tranSPORT service is available to encourage alternative transportation to football games and to alleviate traffic and parking congestion. This service is open to all members of the public.

 (\blacklozenge)

Service is provided to football games at the University of Illinois Memorial Stadium, located at First Street & Kirby Avenue in Champaign. Route 280 tranSPORT service operates to and from all 2018 home games of the University of Illinois Football team.

Frequent 280 tranSPORT service begins <u>2 hours</u> before the start time of football games. The last trips depart for the stadium 15 minutes after the game begins. Passengers may return any time during the game. Return trips depart from the location at which passengers were dropped off. The last return trips depart from the stadium <u>30 minutes</u> after the end of the game. The cost is \$2.00 round trip, payable when boarding. Exact cash fare is preferred.



335 SafeRides service is available on the following dates and times during University of Illinois Fall, Winter, and Spring Breaks:

November 17 to November 24, 2018 from 5:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM) December 21, 2018 to January 12, 2019 from 5:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM) March 16 to March 23, 2019 from 7:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM)

There is no SafeRides on the following Sundays due to reduced service: 2018: November 18, December 23, and December 30 2019: January 6 and March 17 There is no SafeRides service during the University of Illinois Summer Sessions I and II.

What it is:

The purpose of 335 SafeRides is to provide safe transportation to individuals who are generally traveling alone and when no other means of safe transportation are available within the designated 335 SafeRides boundaries. There is a maximum limit of three persons per pick-up location, except at the designated pick-up locations of the Illini Union, ISR, and the Main Library at Armory & Wright. 335 SafeRides does not duplicate fixed-route service already provided by MTD. 335 SafeRides does not provide emergency transportation services to medical facilities. 335 SafeRides does not provide service to and from bars.

How to use it:

This depends on where you are, where you want to go, and what time it is. From Dusk (7:00PM/5:00PM) until 6:00AM you can use 335 SafeRides by calling 217.265.7433 anywhere within the designated boundaries (see map on next page), provided there are three persons or less at the pick-up location and the trip cannot be completed directly on a fixed route. Provide the dispatcher with the following information: your name (first and last), phone number, pick-up location (street address/landmark), and destination. If your trip is within the 335 SafeRides boundaries, the dispatcher will then inform you of a scheduled pick-up time.

Expect waiting times of 15 minutes during the week and up to 30 minutes on the weekend when demand is higher. Upon boarding the 335 SafeRides van, the person who scheduled the trip will be required to display their valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. As a courtesy to other 335 SafeRides passengers, please be at the scheduled location when the operator arrives. Upon arriving at a pick-up location, the 335 SafeRides operator will **only wait two minutes** for passengers to board before continuing to the next scheduled pick-up/drop-off location. Calls for 335 SafeRides will be taken until 6:00AM for trips to be completed by 6:30AM.

From 9:00PM to 3:00AM you can board a 335 SafeRides vehicle without scheduling a pick-up at either Armory & Wright, the Main Library (:27 and :57 after the hour); Illinois Street Residence Hall (:27 and :57 after the hour); or the Illini Union (:00 and :30 after the hour). When boarding the 335 SafeRides van, you will be asked to display your valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. After 3:00AM, routine pick-ups at the Main Library, Illinois Street Residence Hall, and the Illini Union are discontinued. Please call to make arrangements for a pick-up.

If your pick-up and drop-off locations are both directly on any fixed route (example: residence hall to residence hall trips) and/or there are more than three persons traveling together, you will be required to use the fixed routes to complete your trip. A ride on MTD's fixed-route service is also considered a safe ride.



335 SafeRides service is available on the following dates and times during University of Illinois Fall and Spring Semester days: August 24 to November 3, 2018 from 7:00PM until 6:30AM (calls taken until 6:00AM) November 4, 2018 to March 9, 2019 from 5:00PM until 6:30AM (calls taken until 6:00AM)

March 10 to May 10, 2019 from 7:00PM until 6:30AM (calls taken until 6:00AM)

335 SafeRides service is available on the following dates and times during University of Illinois Fall, Winter, and Spring Breaks:

November 17 to November 24, 2018 from 5:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM) December 21, 2018 to January 12, 2019 from 5:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM) March 16 to March 23, 2019 from 7:00PM until 12:30AM (calls taken until 12:00AM)

There is no SafeRides on the following Sundays due to reduced service: 2018: November 18, December 23, and December 30 2019: January 6 and March 17 There is no SafeRides service during the University of Illinois Summer Sessions I and II.

What it is:

The purpose of 335 SafeRides is to provide safe transportation to individuals who are generally traveling alone and when no other means of safe transportation are available within the designated 335 SafeRides boundaries. There is a maximum limit of three persons per pick-up location, except at the designated pick-up locations of the Illini Union, ISR, and the Main Library at Armory & Wright. 335 SafeRides does not duplicate fixed-route service already provided by MTD. 335 SafeRides does not provide emergency transportation services to medical facilities. 335 SafeRides does not provide service to and from bars.

How to use it:

This depends on where you are, where you want to go, and what time it is. From Dusk (7:00PM/5:00PM) until 6:00AM you can use 335 SafeRides by calling 217.265.7433 anywhere within the designated boundaries (see map on next page), provided there are three persons or less at the pick-up location and the trip cannot be completed directly on a fixed route. Provide the dispatcher with the following information: your name (first and last), phone number, pick-up location (street address/landmark), and destination. If your trip is within the 335 SafeRides boundaries, the dispatcher will then inform you of a scheduled pick-up time.

Expect waiting times of 15 minutes during the week and up to 30 minutes on the weekend when demand is higher. Upon boarding the 335 SafeRides van, the person who scheduled the trip will be required to display their valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. As a courtesy to other 335 SafeRides passengers, please be at the scheduled location when the operator arrives. Upon arriving at a pick-up location, the 335 SafeRides operator will **only wait two minutes** for passengers to board before continuing to the next scheduled pick-up/drop-off location. Calls for 335 SafeRides will be taken until 6:00AM for trips to be completed by 6:30AM.

From 9:00PM to 3:00AM you can board a 335 SafeRides vehicle without scheduling a pick-up at either Armory & Wright, the Main Library (:27 and :57 after the hour); Illinois Street Residence Hall (:27 and :57 after the hour); or the Illini Union (:00 and :30 after the hour). When boarding the 335 SafeRides van, you will be asked to display your valid pass or pay the appropriate fare to the 335 SafeRides operator. After 3:00AM, routine pick-ups at the Main Library, Illinois Street Residence Hall, and the Illini Union are discontinued. Please call to make arrangements for a pick-up.

If your pick-up and drop-off locations are both directly on any fixed route (example: residence hall to residence hall trips) and/or there are more than three persons traveling together, you will be required to use the fixed routes to complete your trip. A ride on MTD's fixed-route service is also considered a safe ride.




